Rather the focus is to engage the journey in an authentic, life affirming way which allows you to be true to yourself and to your own understanding of who God is for you.

Living the Questions doesn't attempt to provide easy answers. Instead, it is a resource to help you learn, reflect, journey, and discover. The program will challenge many people's worldview and understanding of the divine. For some, it will be radically new information. For others, it will be an affirmation of what they have known deep down for a long time. For all it will be a safe place to come and explore.
